- 3. www.sir47.org/Event Calendar In an effort to streamline the monthly luncheon signup, we have developed a reservation sign-in system that is an integral part of our Branch 47 website. This RSVP system will greatly aid the chairmen of our special events and Luncheons. Below are the procedures involved in registering for the luncheons on the website. (Please note that if you do not have a computer or cannot use one you can always make a reservation by calling 415 881 7477 and leaving a voice message with your name, Member Number, and menu choice.)
 - 3.a. Go to www.sir47.org

At the **Home** screen, put your cursor on **Calendar** so that the **Event Calendar** appears. Click on the **Event Calendar**.

Depending upon the speed of your internet connection, the list of Events may take a moment to load.

The **November Luncheon** should appear on your screen. Click on **RSVP Now**.

This will take you to the Registration or **Ticket** Screen.

- 3.b.If you are not going to be able to attend, click on **CAN'T GO**. Complete the required information, your name and email address, and then click **FINISH**. You should receive an email confirming that you will NOT be able to attend the luncheon. (It is important to let us know if you cannot attend. We need to inform McInnis of the number of lunches required.)
- 3.c. If you can attend, click on GOING. . Complete the required information, your name and email address, This should take you to the Attendee Registration screen. (Attendee equates to MAIN GUEST, which is you the member). If you bring a guest, at the -1+ click + and you will be asked for name, email and menu choice for you and your guest.

Select the meal you want. Click **FINISH** to complete your reservation.

You should receive a confirmation email shortly afterward from Wordpress not Branch 47.

NOTE: If you want to cancel or change a reservation, add a guest or change a meal, the system provides for all these functions.

Tamalpais Branch Zoom Meeting from homes September 27, 2021

Minutes from Board meeting of August 2021 were moved for acceptance and passed. The August minutes included the provision that the publishing of minutes would occur only following board approval. Amendments to the August meeting were carried out and upon board approval would revert to Ron Kosciusko for publication in the October Tamal Talk.

Big SIR Report:

Frank reported that the annual SIR meeting took place on August 25, 2021. Elections will take place for the Area 8 body for 2022.

Little SIR Report:

Treasurer's Report:

Current status of treasury includes sum of \$8,731 in combined accounts. Two free meals were covered, one for guest and one for a no-show member.

Committee Reports:

It was noted that there are no changes to the membership roster for the month of August 2021.

Old Business:

Google Drive: It was noted that the program will not recognize a new user's computer; Kurt Heilman would have to "approve" of the new user in order for that user to proceed in Google on his own.

Bob Gonzalez reported that 87 members have registered their vaccination records and 96 members have registered their waivers.

All components of the luncheon were scheduled to be in place as well as the members who cover

specific responsibilities. The call-in process has gone well and the Board members expressed their satisfaction with receiving an e-mail acknowledgement.

WEB RSVP new procedures were published and distributed to the membership. Procedures cover RSVP methods and spread sheet will offer entrée choice. There is no option yet for future social events. Discussion covered possible future processes and substitute entry information. Rick Coburn is the current designated coordinator with backup designee to be determined. It was moved, seconded and passed that new procedures for RSVP be published in the upcoming Tamal Talk

New Business:

Very few members remain delinquent with regard to signing waivers or producing a vaccination card.

Finalization of a proposed Holiday Season party should take place at the October 25th meeting. The November meeting will be too close to the proposed party date of December 7th to allow for proper planning.

Discussion took place on having Branch 47 audio/video system available at meetings in case the in-house equipment is not working.

The new slate of officers will be installed at the November meeting. New officers will assume responsibility at the January 2022 meeting.

September 27th meeting was moved for adjournment at 11:30 a.m. The next Branch 47 meeting will take place on Monday, October 25, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. Zoom process will continue for the remainder of 2021.


