Speaker Name: Gil Sanborn will speak on "Defending Democracy in Eastern Europe"

He is a Civilian Aide to the Secretary of the Army for Northern California. Gil has lectured at West Point, the Army War College, the Marine War College, and the National Defense University

Gil will discuss the expansion of NATO after the fall of the Soviet Union, Putin's background and aggression in Eastern Europe, the role of the U.S. Army in supporting NATO, and the 28-year partnership between the California National Guard and Ukraine. Considering the ongoing invasion of Ukraine by Putin's war machine, Gill will provide more perspective on the role of NATO and our own California National Guard.


## **Investors Lunch Bunch**
